

8. a. Mr. Lyle would really be delighted to have such a person. The fact of the matter is, however, that the next position that needs to be filled most desperately is a full-time librarian for the Asa Griggs Candler Library. Cannot fill this until after fills that one.

8. b. Union Catalogue supported by the University Center in Georgia. Contains the cards that make it possible for a student to find out all of the holdings in the Atlanta University Library, as well as all other libraries in the Atlanta-Athens area. Located on Emory campus. MLK Library not yet sufficiently far enough along to get cards but, as a matter of course, cards from there will be in Union Catalogue, just as cards from any other [[other]] library.

8. c. Library currently subscribes to Ebony. Order has been in since early in fall quarter, but first copy not yet received. Have been receiving Ramparts, but they are in such financial difficulty that they may cease to be published. Also take Phylon, primarily about lack [[black]] culture, published by Atlanta [[Atlanta]] University. Also Journal of Negro History. In checking one of more recent bibliographies, Elizabeth W. Miller, compiler, The Negro in America: a Bibliography, 80 books listed; Emory has 76 of them. This is in the field of history.

8. d. Lyle plans next year in Asa Griggs Candler Library to invite student groups to prepare exhibits in display cases, and would be delighted for black students to have turn just like any other students in this sort of display.
