Dear Sir:

The following resolution was presented by President Cliff Fields to the College Council on December 1, 1969.

Whereas, the members of the College Council wish to convey our sense of urgency to the President of Emory University and the Board of Trustees concerning Emory's commitment to recruit more, admit more, and matriculate more black students, and

Whereas, we feel that Emory must allocate funds specifically for these purposes above and beyond those funds normally allocated for scholarships, and

Whereas, the situation is extremely critical in view of the termination of the Rockefeller funds with this year's freshman class, and

Whereas, we feel that this matter should receive the highest priority in budgetary considerations for the coming years,

Be it resolved that we urge the President and Board of Trustees 1) to reaffirm Emory's commitment, 2) to pledge special funds to support the commitment, and 3) to make a public statement of their intent at the earliest possible moment.

This resolution passed unanimously at this meeting, and has also been passed by the Student Government Association and the Student Center Board.
