Dear Reverend Ducree:

In recent meetings with the black student members of the Afro-American Studies Sub-Committee, we have reached the decision that it is necessary to cease temporarily further discussion of the Afro-American Studies Program.

We are still in the process of gathering necessary details for the program, and until such time as the material can be selectively compiled, we feel it would be futile to proceed with further discussions. Also, there is an expressed feeling of disillusionment with the present committee, as well as disappointment with its accomplishments. Therefore, we are requesting a pause in the discussions.

I hope that you will give this request serious consideration
and respond accordingly.
