Resolution

The faculty of Emory College wishes to voice its concern about the expiration of the Rockefeller Foundation grant and the effect this will necessarily have on the fulfillment of Emory's commitment to recruit, enroll and matriculate Black students. We feel that Emory must find funds above and beyond those normally available for scholarships in order to honor this commitment. We urge the continuation of vigorous efforts to secure such funds from outside the University. Should such efforts fail, we believe that priorities in the allocation of available resources should be reviewed and top priority given to funds for additional scholarship which will at a minimum continue the program made possible by the Rockefeller Foundation grant.
